Care Property Invest acquires an up-and-running healthcare project in Vught (The Netherlands)

Schoten, Belgium - Thursday 22 December 2022

Care Property Invest announces the acquisition of the 'Ome Jan' project in Vught (province of North Brabant), an up-and-running care residence with 26 residential units for elderly people suffering from dementia. This recently completed development project was integrated within the Fort Isabella site, an inclusive environment where living, working, education, recreation, and growing older all come together. 'Ome Jan' has a total conventional value of approximately €9.7 million.

The transaction took place in the form of an asset deal whereby Care Property Invest acquired the real estate of this project via its Dutch subsidiary, Care Property Invest.NL9 B.V.

For the operation of the project, Care Property Invest will join forces for the first time with healthcare operator Ome Jan Vught B.V. (part of De Familie), a North Brabant-based player that in addition to residential care also specialises in home care for elderly people with dementia. To this end, they are entering into a new long-term rental agreement of the 'triple net' type with a duration of minimum 25 years (renewable and annually indexable). The project is therefore generating additional income for the Company as of today.

Peter Van Heukelom, CEO of Care Property Invest;

With this project we are partnering for the first time with healthcare operator De Familie, a relatively new, ambitious operator on the Dutch healthcare real estate market who, in addition to 23 years of experience in home care for elderly people suffering from dementia, now wants to focus further on bringing that same specialised approach to small-scale care residences. Including this project, the total number of residential care projects in our portfolio now amounts to 145.'

The operator

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Healthcare entrepreneur Menny Landman started Standby Thuiszorg in 1999, a concept focusing on granting care to elderly people with dementia and incurably ill clients who wish to remain at home (as long as possible). Together with Huub Landman, who joined the organisation in 2015, the organisation grew into a successful business with 2000 caregivers by now. However, they made the observation that it is not always possible for a client in an advanced stage of dementia to live safely at home. As a result, De Familie B.V. was born. With this concept, they wish to respond to this demand and create their own protected environment in the shape of care villas which, under the name 'Wonen bij de Familie (Living with The Family)' and in synergy with the Standby home care concept, quarantee a smooth transition from home care to protected residential care.

Project:	This is a high-quality and exceptionally sustainable (EPC A+++) and modern care complex with 26 units built from a small-scale vision. The spacious rooms are planned with a private bathroom, pantry and, in some cases, even a fenced terrace. The main building, designed in a more classic villa style, houses an office space, a hairdresser, a laundry room, large communal areas to encourage social interaction and a private dining room. Enjoying the greenery can be done in the large gardens surrounding the complex.	
Location:	Just outside the village centre of Vught on the Fort Isabella site, a former fortification used to defend the city of 's-Hertogenbosch. The site was completely redeveloped into an environment where living, working, education, recreation and growing older all come together, including restaurants, businesses, a nursery, a school and residential apartments. The project is easily accessible by car via the nearby A2 motorway and by public transport thanks to a train station 3 km away.	
Sustainability:	The project was awarded an EPC A+++ certificate (Building Energy Rating). To this end, the care residence was connected to the collective heating network and planned with underfloor heating, a heat pump, a balanced ventilation system and solar control glazing supplemented by sun blinds on the sun-exposed sides. As a result, the development of 'Ome Jan' is fully in line with Care Property Invest's sustainability vision.
